George was a past PFA Board member, served a term as board vice president, and recipient of the Rothrock Award. George, also served as a chair of the PA Tree Farm Committee, the PA Forest Stewardship committee, helped to establish the Clarion County Forest Stewardship Committee, and in 1998 George and his wife Joan were named National Tree Farmers of the year.
