Locations / Directions

From Exit 14 of I-79, take Highway 21 west through Waynesburg, Pennsylvania. From the west edge of Waynesburg to the west side of Rogersville, Routes 21 and 18 are joined. Look for the separation of Routes 21 and 18 west of Rogersville. Follow Route 21. Just beyond this intersection, notice the sign that says Rutan 4 miles. As you are nearing Rutan, notice the covered bridge (Scott Bridge) on your left. On down the road on your right, notice a farmstead with a silo and a farm house with a new green metal roof. Note the small sign on the right that says Rutan. Slow down and put your left turning signal on. In the middle of a very sharp turn in the highway, turn left onto Jacobs Run Road (SR 3007). Travel a short distance and take the first left onto Claylick Road (SR 3022). Cross the metal grate bridge and pass the Watson Farm on your left, followed by Pettit Road on your right. On down the road is a 2-story old farm house on the left. After passing the new double wide on your left, look for a tree farm sign on the left (east) side of the road. The next intersection is with Muddy Hollow Road (T521). Notice the Tree Farm and Forest Stewardship signs on the fence and the 2 large Norway spruce (one on each side of Muddy Hollow Road. Turn left onto Muddy Hollow Road. You have arrived.

Look for a sign directing you to an appropriate place to park.

Once parked, walk up the gas well road with the green open gate and the Tree Farm sign. The field day will convene at the wooden garage and tent at the top of the drive. Volunteers will be available to direct participants.

Description

The Perkeys have engaged 11 presenters to explain numerous forestry and wildlife habitat treatments, share minerals management experiences, discuss forest regeneration practices, and relate road construction and maintenance history.

Forestry and natural resource professionals will be stationed along pre-planned walkways discussing various relevant management activities and observations. Visitors will tour the property, spending as much or as little time as they wish at the educational stations they chose to visit. Volunteer ambassadors will help visitors locate and join presentations as they are in progress. Dress appropriately for the weather and your walking ability.
