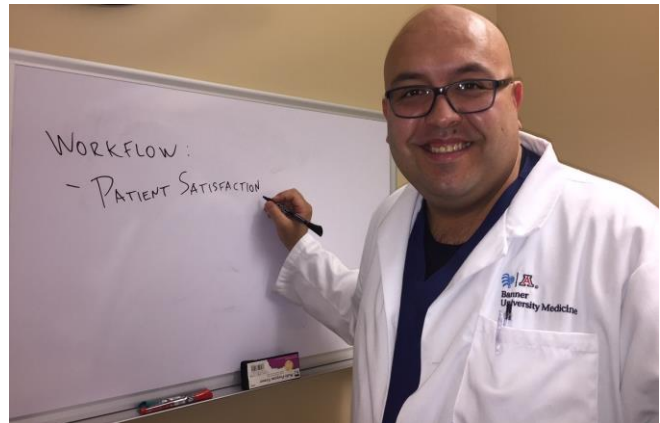
APPLICATION MATERIALS SHOULD INCLUDE

- Current CV
- Statement of career goals
- Statement of research interests
- Description of match with potential MU SSON mentors
- PhD/DNS preparation: program, date, mentors, transcript
- Statement of needed resources (office or lab space, statistical support, etc.)
- Copies of first-authored publications or manuscripts in preparation
- Brief research proposal



FELLOW SELECTION CRITERIA INCLUDE

- Motivation and discipline to develop a vigorous program of research
- Likelihood that research interests are compatible with an externally-fundable program of research
- MU SSON PhD research faculty member willing to mentor the post-doctoral applicant
- Preference will be given to an applicant pursuing symptom or health behavior science (SHBS) topic



BENEFITS AND TIMELINE

The full-time fellowship will last 12 months. The start date may be between June 1 and September 1, depending on the fellow's other commitments. The fellowship includes a stipend, tuition support, research conference travel allowance, laptop computer, and pilot project costs.
