



Parental Objection to Release of Student Information to Military Recruiters

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Under the federal "No Child Left Behind" Act, public high schools must give the names, addresses and telephone numbers of students to military recruiters if the recruiters request the information (P.L. 107-110, Section 9528; 10 USC 503). However, students or their parents have the right to instruct the school in writing that this information is not to be released.

If you do not consent to the release of this information to military recruiters, please complete the form below and return it to the Guidance Office by October 3.

Please note that this form is given to students at the beginning of their junior year and again at the beginning of their senior year and will need to be completed each year even if you have previously notified the school of your wishes.
