Our Week at a Glance

Reading/Writing Workshop: Our poem of the week will be "Spring." We will practice -ing endings.. In phonics, we will practice adding ending to words such as, -ing, -er and -ed. In writing we will be writing acrostic poems and designing and writing about an incredible egg.
