Good Evening Second Grade Families,

We hope you had a wonderful weekend. Last week was a full week of learning, students took their subtracting three digit numbers assessment, continued with their informational writing prompt discussing community workers, compared and contrasted various books for our author study, and learned more about producers, consumers, and markets to prepare for our upcoming 2nd grade market. Students also had the opportunity to participate in a school wide project for Black History Month. We created a museum through the decades as a school learning about various meaningful events over the years in African American History, students then got to walk around the multipurpose room viewing all of the projects created by the grades.

A note about our new PBL project starting. Last week a half sheet piece a paper was put in folders about our next PBL project. On this paper was information about an item your child chose to build/make for our 2nd Grade market. Please talk with them about their project and what they would like to build, and decide on materials they will use. Please write this information on the half sheet of paper, sign, and return. Should you and your child discuss their project and change what was originally written you may do that we just ask that you write the updated information on the paper. Also, each student must make a minimum quantity of 10 items to be sold. (Ex: If they chose bracelets they must make a minimum of 10 bracelets to be sold in the market). You may begin sending in items tomorrow. Thank you for your support as we begin our next PBL. We cannot wait to see all students' creations.
