Good Afternoon,

Can you believe that we are in the last 9 weeks of school? This school year has flown by and these last 9 weeks are going to go by super fast!!! I hope everyone had a wonderful weekend and enjoyed this beautiful weather. We are super excited for our field trip to Camp Cherokee tomorrow. This weeks email is rather lengthy but please read through it in its entirety because it contains important information regarding the field trip.

CAMP CHEROKEE Our field trip is tomorrow April 1st. Buses will be here at 8:00 and we will be departing shortly after. Please make sure your child is at school by 7:50 so we can leave on time. Students and chaperones will need to bring a bagged lunch and a water bottle. Please make sure your child dresses comfortably and wears tennis shoes because we will be walking a lot. As of right now the weather is going to be partly sunny with a high of 57 degrees. You may want to send a jacket with your child for the morning due to the temperatures still being fairly cold. Also, some of the trails will be shaded as well. If your child has a Riverwalk shirt please have them wear it tomorrow! Chaperones-You will need to meet us at the school first. When you arrive at school, you will need to have your i.d. scanned at the computer in the lobby. We will meet you in lobby on our way out. If your child is riding with you they may leave with you at this time. I will give each chaperone the address to Camp Cherokee and/or you can also follow the buses.
