4th Grade Happenings

Math: This week in Math, we will be focusing on adding and subtracting mixed numbers. Students really got the hang of adding and subtracting like fractions so I have a good feeling about mixed numbers as well. Students will be given a fraction math project to work on this week and next. They are responsible for completing this independently and turn it in next week. Our fractions retest will be this Friday as well as our multiplication fluency quiz.
