4th Grade Happenings

Math: I am so proud of how well students did on their fractions retest! They really took their time and asked questions. We will be wrapping up Ch. 9 this week by learning how to multiply fractions by whole numbers. We will be reviewing ch. 9 on Tuesday and Wednesday, then be testing on Thursday. We will dip our toes into Ch. 10 on Friday, which starts talking about decimals. Students are to finish working on their pizza fractions math projects and they will be collected on Friday.

ELA: In reading, we will be focusing on how to make inferences from different passages. In grammar, we will be reviewing over subordinating conjunctions. Students are to work on their packets throughout the week and they will be due on Friday. For spelling, we are focusing on sight words for our students. **They words for this week are as follows: brought, remember, able, himself, black, certain, surface, anything, really, and letter.**

Writing: Students will continue to practice on writing TDAs. Students have been making excellent progress on them and have been adding such great details, increasing their voice, and using great transition words! Students will work on them from Monday-Wednesday and on Thursday, we will have our "Battle Royale of TDAs".

PBL: We will be continuing to learn about significant events that happened during the civil war. Students will be learning about struggles over slavery, the abolitionist movement, significant battles of the civil war, and north vs south. Student's packets will be due on Friday!
