4th Grade Happenings

Math: We are going to pick up where we left off in math before state testing this week. We will be focusing on how to convert units of time, display measurement data on a line plot, and how to solve measurement problems. We will have a check my progress quiz on Wednesday!

ELA: This week in ELA, students will be using their creativity and create their own chapter books. Students will be responsible for making a title page, about the author page, table of contents page, and atlas 6 chapters.
