We begin informational writing this week. We just took a writing test on opinion writing and everyone did so well! I am so proud of their progress.

I do need to ask you to talk to your child about doing their work during centers. On the report card I must grade how well your child reads and writes independently. I do this during center time when I am teaching small group reading. Here lately we have had a lot of talking and not finishing our work. Some of the grades went down this quarter on the report card because of all the talking and not finishing the reading and writing assignments. Please talk to your child about this.
