## Our Week at a Glance

**Reading/Writing Workshop:** Our poem of the week will be a "Bats, Bats, Bats." We will work on the -at word family. We will hunt for long vowel sounds in the poem. We will read various books that include pumpkins, bats and fall. We will read a non-fiction book on bats and write facts learned from the book.

**Review 10 most commonly used words:** will, up, other, about, out, many, then, them, these, so. In phonics the students will practice L-Blends.

**Math:** We will continue to practice counting by 1's, 5's and 10's and identifying numbers. The students will practice addition facts and word problems. They will practice measuring items using the words lighter/heavier.

**PBL:** Will conduct a pumpkin investigation. We will collect data and write about our findings. Will a pumpkin sink or float?
