Our Week at a Glance

Reading/Writing Workshop: Our poem of the week will be "Point to It." In phonics, we will practice long o and long i words and find out why words have long vowel sounds. We will practice -oi words. In writing we will be writing acrostic poems and list poems. We will begin our fairy tale unit and comparing text.

Math: We will be working on subtraction and two digit addition as well as number patterns. Check your child's folder for which number group to study for the addition fluency test on Friday.

PBL: Driving question: How do plants and animals use natural resources to survive?

We will continue our plant unit. Students will choose a region they would like to do their project on. They will work in groups to design a background and write facts about their region. They will create an animal that lives in their region.
