Covid-19 Precautions in our vehicles

Safety during our in-car driving lessons continues to be our #1 priority at Drive Smart Georgia. Due to the highly contagious Delta variant, Drive Smart Georgia has tightened our COVID-19 safety precautions in our vehicles and classrooms in order to keep our students and staff safe.

- All lessons will still continue to be **conducted from our locations** in order to give our instructors more time to disinfect our vehicles between sessions.
- ALL students and instructors **MUST** wear a **mask in the vehicle** during the entire road test or driving lesson. This applies to **all vaccinated and non-vaccinated students and instructors**.
- To ensure a super safe lesson, our instructor will take your student's temperature with a **no-contact scan thermometer**. Rest assured that our instructor will also be fever-free. All instructors have strict guidelines to be able to conduct driving lessons. If you'd prefer to use your own thermometer from home, be sure to bring it.
- Upon arrival, **please stay in your vehicle**. You will receive a text from your instructor when your driving lesson is scheduled to start. The text will include the vehicle number of the car your child will use for the lesson. Vehicle numbers are located on the front and back bumpers of our cars. Our instructor will be standing next to the vehicle. We're doing this to limit your contact with our office staff. Everything will be conducted outside or in the vehicle.
- Instructors will **sanitize** every surface, switch, mirror, steering wheel, seats and more before and after each driving lesson.
