## **Covid-19 Precautions at Drive Smart Georgia**

1. All students must **wait outside** prior to class, spaced 6' apart while in line.
2. Prior to entering the classroom, each student must answer a quick **health questionnaire** and have their temperature checked with a **no-contact scan thermometer**.
3. All chairs in our classrooms will be spaced a minimum of **6' apart**.
4. All students and the teacher **must wear a clean mask** during the duration of all classes.
5. Before and after each and every class, Drive Smart Georgia will use a **commercial-grade disinfecting unit** that is 100% safe to not only remove germs, but to kill them. This is an above and beyond precaution that we are happy to offer.
6. In addition to using our commercial-grade disinfection unit, our teacher will **sanitize all surfaces** (doors, doorknobs, light switches, desks, chairs, faucets, desks, chairs, pens – everything that is touched!) **three times per day**. Yes, we have plenty of hand sanitizer for all students too. Before and after breaks, students will be asked to wash their hands, the best defense against COVID-19.
7. Our doors will remain open (except during inclement weather) in order to **circulate fresh air** in our classrooms.
8. All classroom teachers must report their temperature each morning of class. They have signed agreements that they will **NOT** report to work if they are not feeling well. They have also agreed to not wear the same clothing that they wore during the previous class (unless the clothing was washed between classes), or while visiting any public building.
9. For the safety of our students and staff, **parents will not be allowed** in our lobby or classrooms. Interaction among the teacher and office staff will be very limited and 6 ft. apart.
10. Teachers will take the students outside as often as possible for **fresh air breaks**, with 6' distancing rules in place.
