

Calling all Elementary Artists

We need your help designing our next set of greeting cards! Each week, our Pastors send cards to brighten the day of someone in our congregation and your artwork could be on the front!

Step 1: Choose one of the two Bible stories to inspire your artwork:

- The Creation Story - Genesis 1 - Key verse: "God saw everything that God had made, and indeed, it was very good."
- Noah and the Ark - Genesis 6-9 - Key Verse: "I have set my bow in the clouds, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth."
- Moses and the Red Sea - Exodus 14 - Key Verse: "But Moses stretched out his hand over the sea. The Lord drove the sea back by a strong east wind all night and turned the sea into dry land."
- Jesus Calms the Sea - Mark 4:35-42- Key Verse: "And they were filled with great awe and said to one another, 'Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?'"
- The Lost Son - Luke 15 - Key Verse: "But while he was still far off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion; he ran and put his arms around him and kissed him."
- The Feeding of the Five Thousand - Matthew 14:13-21 - Key Verse: "Taking the five loaves and two fish, Jesus looked up to heaven, and blessed and broke the loaves, and gave them to the disciples and the disciples gave them to the crowds. And all ate and were filled."

Step 2: Create your artwork on a piece of paper no larger than 8.5" x 11".

Step 3: You may use any medium you'd like - paint, watercolor, colored pencils, crayons, or markers are all welcome!

Step 4: Make sure your art is bright, joyful, and uplifting - something that would make someone smile.

Step 5: Write your name, grade, and Bible story title on the back of your artwork and submit your finished artwork to Mrs. Kimberly by Sunday, December 21:
