Recently, I heard a new insight about John 4, and the story of Jesus' encounter with the woman at the well. The insight came from Ryan Spurrier, the pastoral leader of Wesley Campus Ministry at UNC-Chapel Hill. Ryan shared that at UNC Wesley there is an understanding that Jacob's well in John 4 began as a gathering place but **became a place of sending**. The woman encountered Jesus and **was sent forth** with a powerful story to tell. Others came to believe, because of her testimony. The literal definition of apostle is "one who is sent." Therefore, the woman at the well was a Christian apostle!

Hayes Barton UMC also has a Well. The Well extends down three stories intersecting with our youth area, a Sunday morning gathering space, and down to our children's ministry area. Yes, the Well touches us in every age and stage. Hayes Barton's Well reminds us that when we gather in this place we receive living water that nourishes and sustains us. However, God also **sends us out** from the Well—or scatters us if you will—to be apostles for Jesus Christ.

During the last decade, HBUMC's Scattered to Serve has evolved from a single day of service to a season of projects. This spring, I encourage you to find a project to engage so that we all might be sent forth from HBUMC's Well and scattered to be apostles for Christ's work in the world.

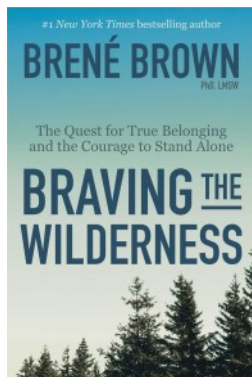
