2024 PRAYER FOCUS: SALT & LIGHT

"You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot." "Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven!" Matthew 5:13; 16

For the past several years the Missionary Church has maintained a strong focus on making disciples to the fourth generation. World Partners has championed disciple-makers who are leading the charge among unreached people groups in some of the most difficult parts of the world. North American churches have been reevaluating vision, programs and strategies with the question in mind: "Will this help us multiply disciples?"

There is also a growing sense of urgency about reaching the next generation. There is one Missionary Church group that connects monthly just to pray for a multiplication of disciples among the next generation.

Paul wrote to the Colossians, "Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone" (Colossians 4:6). Our lives are to be such that others will see our good works and glorify our Father in heaven. Our speech is to be full of grace and seasoned with salt so that our speech draws people to Christ rather than repels them.

There is a certain humility with being salt and light. It requires thinking first of Jesus and how we reflect him and then thinking of others and praying that our lives and speech will move people to seek Jesus. This kind of life is born out of a place of intimacy with Jesus. I cannot live the Jesus-life apart from a deep love for Him that continues to grow as we fellowship with Him.

JANUARY PRAYER FOCUS — INTIMACY WITH JESUS

We are changing the format this year. Instead of a daily scripture and prayer, we want to focus on a different region of the Missionary Church each week and a different department at Bethel University. We also want to challenge everyone to look at the theme of the month and ask each week what the Lord wants to say to us.

WEEK #1
