Share the Plate recipient for March is Friends of the Saugatucket. It is literally our natural neighbor just steps away from our Lily Pads' home. Their mission is "to promote and enhance the natural and cultural features of the Saugatucket River and its watershed for the benefit of the river and its surrounding lands and community". Our UU congregation knows that Peace Dale was home to the Narragansett people for millennia. It is not surprising that the word "Saugatucket" is a Narragansett word meaning "at the outlet of the tribal river".

Friends of the Saugatucket was formed in 2021 when it was learned that this watershed did not have a current advocacy group. In the short time this organization has been around, they are on the ground, and river, helping to make a positive difference in the lives of all.
