Our Unitarian Universalist Seven Principles are under consideration for significant revision. For this 3-session course, we will answer such important questions as:

- What is essential to you about being a Unitarian Universalist?
- How do we balance our deeply held value of individual freedom of belief with the common good we strive for in our covenant?
- What are our shared UU Values?
- What are your hopes for our UU future?

“Article 2” of our bylaws includes what many people recognize as the 7 Principles, 6 sources, the Purposes of the UU and our statements of Inclusion and Freedom of Belief. All of these are up for reconsideration.

This discussion has been underway in the UU world, and now it’s our turn to engage with the draft statements and focused discussion questions that other UUs around the country are talking about. There will be opportunities to send feedback to the “Article 2 Study Commission” while they prepare their final report for the 2023 UUA General Assembly.
