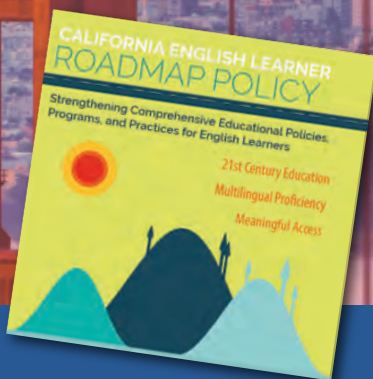

### SESSION DESCRIPTION

The CABE 2020 Administrative Leadership Symposium will provide superintendents, school board members, district and site leaders with an inside look into what it takes to imagine, innovate, develop, grow and sustain successful multiliteracy programs PreK-16. In 2016, with the passage of Proposition 58 in California, the doors to multilingual programs were swung wide open, pushing aside old policy and antiquated approaches to meeting the needs of English Learners. Over three years after its passage, a dynamic shift is occurring in our state to expand multilingual programs and prepare our students for a truly global workforce guided by the EL Roadmap Policy.

There are many intentional, dynamic elements that a district must consider when implementing a systems-based approach to multiliteracy programs. In this year's Administrative Leadership Symposium, we will engage with:
