WHAT GOALS DOES PROJECT 2INSPIRE PROGRAM INCLUDE?

- ▶ **Reduces** the educational gap of students at risk.
- ▶ **Increases** the leadership skills, knowledge development, and educational commitment of parents, to raise the academic achievements of their children.
- ▶ **Increases** the capacity of schools and districts to maintain a commitment to a high quality parent leadership program focused on student achievement.
- ▶ **Develops** the leadership skills of parents, as trainers of other parents, in schools.
- ▶ It **helps** parents guide the academic success of their children at home and at school.
- ▶ **Strengthens** families and the community through the creation of partnerships between family, school and community.
- ▶ A **study-based program** that supports parent leadership so that students can reach their maximum potential- academically, emotionally, and personally.

Awareness Level

- ▶ 12 sessions of an hour and a half each
- ▶ Knowledge of critical information about the California Education System and how it affects students and families
- ▶ Parents can attend a variable number of sessions.



Expert Level

- ▶ 16 3-hour modules
- ▶ Participants must have completed level 2 to be part of this level.
- ▶ Development and refinement of knowledge and leadership skills
- ▶ Parents who complete the program may offer level one curriculum services to other parents in their schools (license fees apply)



Mastery Level

- ▶ 12 sessions of 3 hours each
- ▶ In-depth knowledge of critical information about the California educational system and how it affects students and families
- ▶ Focused on the participant and significantly more intensive in terms of content (deeper coverage), time and effort.
- ▶ Participants must complete the 12 training modules, for a total of 36 hours of face-to-face learning activities based on projects



Advanced Leadership Level

- ▶ 8 3-hour modules
- ▶ Parents will continue to receive leadership skills
- ▶ Efficient communication
- ▶ They will learn to follow the school protocol
- ▶ Organizational skills
- ▶ They will learn about conflict resolution in a positive way
- ▶ Collaboration and team formation

Plaza Comunitaria is an educational program that offers online literacy courses, primary and secondary level for Spanish speaking adults in a school environment.
