


¿Do you want to help your Spanish-speaking families obtain their Elementary or Secondary Certificate? Learn more about how to bring CABE's Plaza Comunitaria Trainer of Trainer to your District or Site.

What does the Three- Day Trainer of Trainer include:

1. A three-day in depth training with assigned staff who will run your Plaza Comunitaria
2. Books and supporting materials for the Plaza Comunitaria implementation in connection with CABE and district contact and support
3. Plaza Comunitaria Coordinator handles all enrollment, administrative support with Mexican Consulate, and certification processing for students
4. Up to 10 hours of technical support via video calls, conference calls and/or emails with partnered sites
5. A contract by your district to provide services



The California Association for Bilingual Education (CABE) in collaboration with the Mexican Consulate in Los Angeles offers a Trainer of Trainer to implement an innovative program called Plaza Comunitaria. The program consists of three levels of progression which teach Spanish speaking adults to read and write in their native tongue and to complete their elementary and secondary education. Upon the completion of this program the student will receive a diploma from the Mexican Secretary of Public Education. Which will allow them to continue their education in areas such as ESL, GED,etc.

By completing the Plaza Comunitaria Trainer of Trainer (TOT) program, a district is able to offer this model program for Spanish speaking parents at their schools who wish to resume or complete their studies in their native language. Parents and families who complete their education are able to participate in helping their child to succeed academically and build bridges of communication between the family and the school. In addition, upon completion of their high school education, students are able to transition into ESL courses with a higher rate of success.
