

New Concert Series

We are pleased to announce a 3-concert series this season, sponsored by the Bob and Mary Davis Music Trust. All three events are on Saturday evenings at 7:00 p.m., and as befits the historic nature of the church, all three focus on early music, either from just before the parish was founded, or in the early days of the parish.

First is an organ recital by Gary Harney, on **November 19th, 2022**. Music for this program will be by Buxtehude, Bach, Guilain, Walton, Archer, and Willan.

Second is a performance by the Immanuel Bach Consort, including a special performance of Bach's tour-de-force "Chaconne" for unaccompanied violin, played by our Baroque violinist, Sylvia Ahramjian. This program is on **February 25th, 2023**.

Finally, the early music group *Filament* (from Philadelphia) will present our final program of the season, performing music from just before the founding of the parish, as well as music written in the parish's early years. Harpsichordist John Walthausen directs this ensemble of Baroque violin, viola da gamba, and harpsichord. This final concert is on **April 15th, 2023**.

All programs are free and open to the public. We hope you will come hear some historic music in an historic space.
