Moisés Santiesteban is a Cuban organist who contributes with his work as a performer, teacher and researcher to the rescue, promotion and diffusion of the Cuban sacred musical heritage.

Moises is the titular organist of The Cathedral of the Virgin Mary of the Immaculate Conception, soloist of the National Concert Music Center (CNMC), general coordinator and teacher of the Sacred Music Chair of the Father Félix Varela Institute of Ecclesiastical Studies, the organ teacher of the study programs coordinated by the Esteban Salas Musical Heritage Office at the San Gerónimo University College of Havana (University of Havana) and teacher of the Interpretation Masterclass in Organ and Piano at the National School of Art.

As a performer, he has participated as a soloist and chamber musician in the organ, piano and harpsichord at important festivals and concert tours in countries such as Cuba, Spain, Germany, Poland and Switzerland.

He is slated to record a solo organ CD in Poland in May of 2017.
