MRS LISA KNUTSON

A church musician and organist for over 25 years, Lisa Knutson received a Bachelor of Music degree in organ performance from the University of Nebraska - Lincoln, studying with Bach scholar George Ritchie, which allowed her to perform in master-classes and recitals in the US and in Naumburg, Germany. She then held the position of Music Intern for the Church of the Covenant with professor Todd Wilson at the Cleveland Institute of Music. She gained further studies in the Ward Method of Catholic music education from CUA's International Ward Center and has taught in this method for 12 years. Lisa is Music Director for Saint Mary Church (FSSP) in Conshohocken, PA, since 2019. She directs chant and polyphonic ensembles, and oversees the multi-tiered Chorister program. In previous positions she lead adult and children's choirs, been a clinician for sacred music workshops, and founded a youth orchestra for Mankato's underprivileged. Together with her husband Nathan, they have volunteered for the Zipoli Institute for Sacred Music, working to restore sacred music in the world-wide missions of the Institute of the Incarnate Word, giving events in Minnesota, California, Maryland, Italy and the Philippines. Lisa has published on the artistic and musical work of the Jesuit Missionaries in the Reductions, and seeks to bring the missionary zeal for beauty to all her musical endeavors, and at home. The Knutsons are blessed with 6 children, nine chickens and numerous barn cats.
