Father Dennis Gill

***(Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy)**

Father Gill is the Rector and Pastor of the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul and the Director of the Office for Divine Worship. Father Gill completed his graduate studies in the Sacred Liturgy at the Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. and the Pontifical Liturgical Institute of Saint Anselmo in Rome. In addition to multiple parish assignments he served a five year term as the Director of Liturgy at the Pontifical North American College in Vatican City State. He is also a professor of Sacred Liturgy at Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary. Father has authored 2 books: **Music in Catholic Liturgy: A Pastoral and Theological Companion to Sing to the Lord** and **Ars Celebrandi: An Artful and Careful Celebration of the Eucharist**.
