- 1) Ethnos Canada (Durham/Ontario) is now an accepted SOWER project ON-550. Ethnos is a residential training center for missionaries and their families, preparing to serve on the mission field. August (2022) is the only month available for SOWER volunteering. Reason: Ethnos is a residential missionary training center that provides on-site accommodations (including RV pads) for their students and families. The limited number of RV pads are reserved for their students' use months in advance; creating a challenge to accommodate SOWER volunteers this late in the 2022 season. The 2023 season looks more promising.
- 2) Elim Lodge Ministries (near Peterborough) has received its official approval as a SOWER Host ON-556. Elim is a family orientated Christian Retreat and Conference Centre on Pigeon Lake (Trent Water System)
- 3) Maple Grove Christian Retreat Centre (Thamesford/ON) is in the beginning stages of their "Request for Assistance" application. FYI, the application process is a detailed procedure for the applicant, which takes time.
- 4) Word of Life (Owen Sound/ON) was compelled to withdraw their SOWER application due to a recent decision to start construction of a much needed 4-plex Student Accommodation Complex; requiring the demolition of their existing RV pads, leaving no option for the placement of SOWER units.
- 5) Thank you to the volunteer couples who committed to being Project Sponsor for our new and potentially upcoming project ministries.
- 6) Thankful for those Christian couples in our Canada East division who are in the Membership process.

- 7) My personal words of appreciation to our SOWER office staff and to our VP for mentoring (so patiently) your new Canada East Area Representatives.
- 8) Thankful to organizations such as One Hope Canada (OHC) who continue to express their appreciation for SOWER volunteer activities at their various facilities, such as MB-490 & MB-534. Since OHC ministries are nationwide, further SOWER expansion with OHC is promising within both the Canada East & West divisions. 


