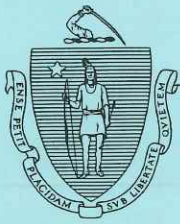

IN THE YEAR OF TWO THOUSAND AND EIGHT

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO PUBLIC ACCESS FOR RECREATIONAL TRAILS

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
And by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. ~~The subsection (a)~~ of section 17C of chapter 21 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "limitation", in line 3, the following words:- , railroad and utility corridors, easements and rights of way.

SECTION 2. <sup>said</sup> The subsection (b) of section 17C of chapter 21, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following <sup>2</sup> sentences:- <sup>For the purposes of this section,</sup> The term "person" as used in this section shall be deemed to include the person having <sup>any</sup> interest in the land, his agent, manager, or licensee and shall include, without limitation, any governmental body, agency or instrumentality, <sup>a</sup> nonprofit corporation, trust, association, corporation, company, or ~~any~~ other business organization and any director, officer, trustee, member, employee, authorized volunteer, or agent thereof. ~~The terms~~ "structures,

- 12 buildings and equipment" ~~as used in this section shall be deemed to~~ include any structure,  
13 building or equipment used by an electric company, transmission company, distribution  
14 company, gas company or railroad in the operation of its business.

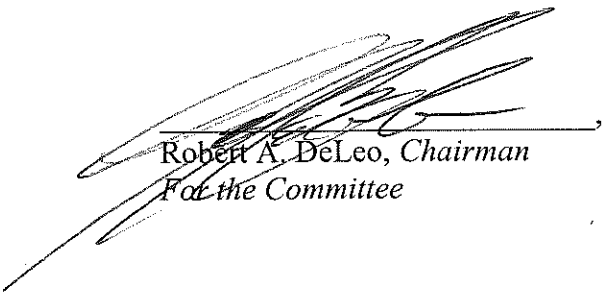

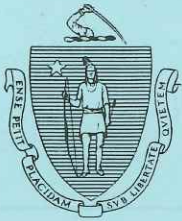

RELATIVE TO PUBLIC ACCESS FOR RECREATIONAL TRAILS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
And by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The subsection (b) of section 17C of chapter 21 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence  
3 and inserting in place thereof the following two sentences:- The term "person" as used in this  
4 section shall be deemed to include the person having any interest in the land, his agent,  
5 manager, or licensee and shall include without limitation, any governmental body, agency or  
6 instrumentality, nonprofit corporation, trust, association, corporation, company, or any other  
7 business organization and any director, officer, trustee, member, employee, authorized  
8 volunteer, or agent thereof. The terms "structures, buildings and equipment" as used in this  
9 section shall be deemed to include any structure, building or equipment used by an electric  
10 company, transmission company, distribution company or gas company in the operation of its  
11 business.
