




Severe Storms will impact the area today

March 6, 2026
5:14 AM

Key Messages

- A few strong storms are possible this morning/early afternoon across southeast Kansas
- A second round of storms are expected to re-develop later this afternoon and evening over central KS, then progress southeast during the night.
- This second round of storms will have a greater risk for severe weather. **Large hail, damaging winds, locally heavy rainfall, and a chance for a strong tornado** will all be possible.




A Strong Tornado Possible

Forecast Confidence for Today

March 6, 2026
5:14 AM

Location

Low

Medium

High

Confidence is medium to high that storms re-develop along the cold front in central Kansas then march southeast. Confidence is lower for isolated storms developing out ahead of the front.

Timing

Low

Medium

High

Confidence remains high that a line of thunderstorms will re-develop late this afternoon and spread southeast through the night time hours. Confidence remains lower for isolated storms to develop ahead of the cold front during the late afternoon and evening hours.


Magnitude

Low

Medium

High

With abundant clouds reducing daytime heating, confidence in the magnitude of severe weather remains low to medium.



Risk of Severe Storms:



ENHANCED RISK

Numerous severe storms possible.

Some longer lived severe storms -- a few intense storms possible.

Have multiple ways to get NWS warnings and seek shelter immediately when warnings are issued for your location.
