Key Messages

- Thunderstorms are expected to develop late this afternoon and increase in coverage and severity during the evening and late evening hours. The more intense storms will mainly affect south central and southeast Kansas.



Forecast Confidence

Confidence is Medium to High that the more intense thunderstorms will develop further south along a cold front, and affect mainly south central and southeast Kansas.

Timing

Confidence is High that storms will develop after 5 pm today then become more widespread after 7 pm. The severe threat should begin to diminish Midnight to 2AM

Magnitude

Large hail up to golf ball size and damaging winds up to 70 mph looks to be the main threats. If storms start to cluster, the hail threat would be reduced some and could begin to produce damaging winds along with heavy rain.
