

Winter Storm for Today-Tuesday

Key Messages

- Moderate to heavy snow with blowing and drifting late today into Tuesday.
- Travel will become very difficult to impossible over central Kansas
- Cold on Tuesday & Much colder Friday and this weekend (well below zero wind chills)

Timing

- Along and north of I-70: This afternoon into Tuesday morning
- **South of I-70:** This evening into Tuesday morning

What Has Changed NEW

- Increased snowfall amounts area-wide
- Added McPherson, Marion, and Chase counties to the Winter Storm Warning
- Added Harper, Sumner, and Cowley counties to the Winter Weather Advisory



WHAT


Moderate to heavy snow with Ο blowing and drifting snow

Magnitude




Confidence is high for moderate to heavy snow with significant blowing and drifting. Dangerous whiteout conditions will occur at times, especially over portions of central Kansas.
