RE: Lower Doses of Johnson & Johnson Expected in Coming Weeks

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment was notified on Tuesday, April 6 of a significant decrease in Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine allocations coming to Kansas. Previously, the projected allocations for delivery next week and the following weeks was 15,800 each week, but this has now been dropped to 5,000 doses statewide for the week of April 12 and 1,700 doses statewide projected for the weeks of April 19 and 26. As a point of reference, 47,100 doses of Johnson & Johnson were delivered to Kansas this week.

We are alerting all providers now as this will have significant impact on planning for the coming weeks. Pfizer and Moderna vaccine allocations are projected to remain consistent to what has been projected and received in recent weeks.
