Key Messages

- **Two rounds of light-moderate snow with breezy/gusty north winds:**
 - Late Thursday through early Friday (mainly northern half of KS, and far southeast KS)
 - Sunday through early Monday (areawide)
- **Bitter cold Arctic air, dangerous wind chills:**
 - Late Thursday through Tuesday or Wednesday of next week

WHAT

- Light to modest accumulating snowfall amounts.
- Stout/gusty north winds.
- Falling temperatures.

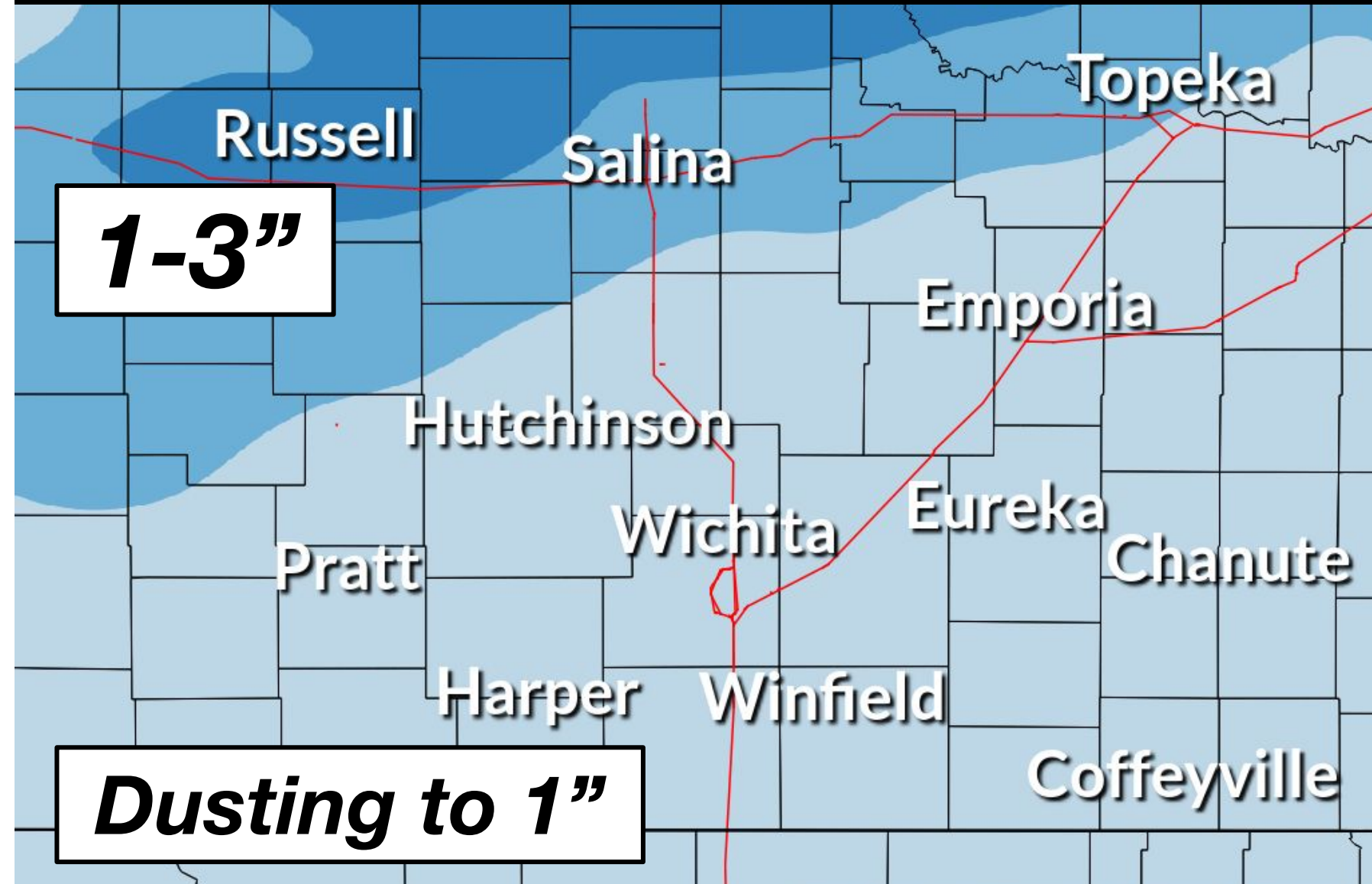
WHEN

- Late Thursday through early Friday.

IMPACTS

- Hazardous travel likely in snow, blowing snow, and low visibilities.

WHAT

- Light to modest accumulating snowfall amounts.
- Breezy/gusty north winds.
- Very cold temperatures.

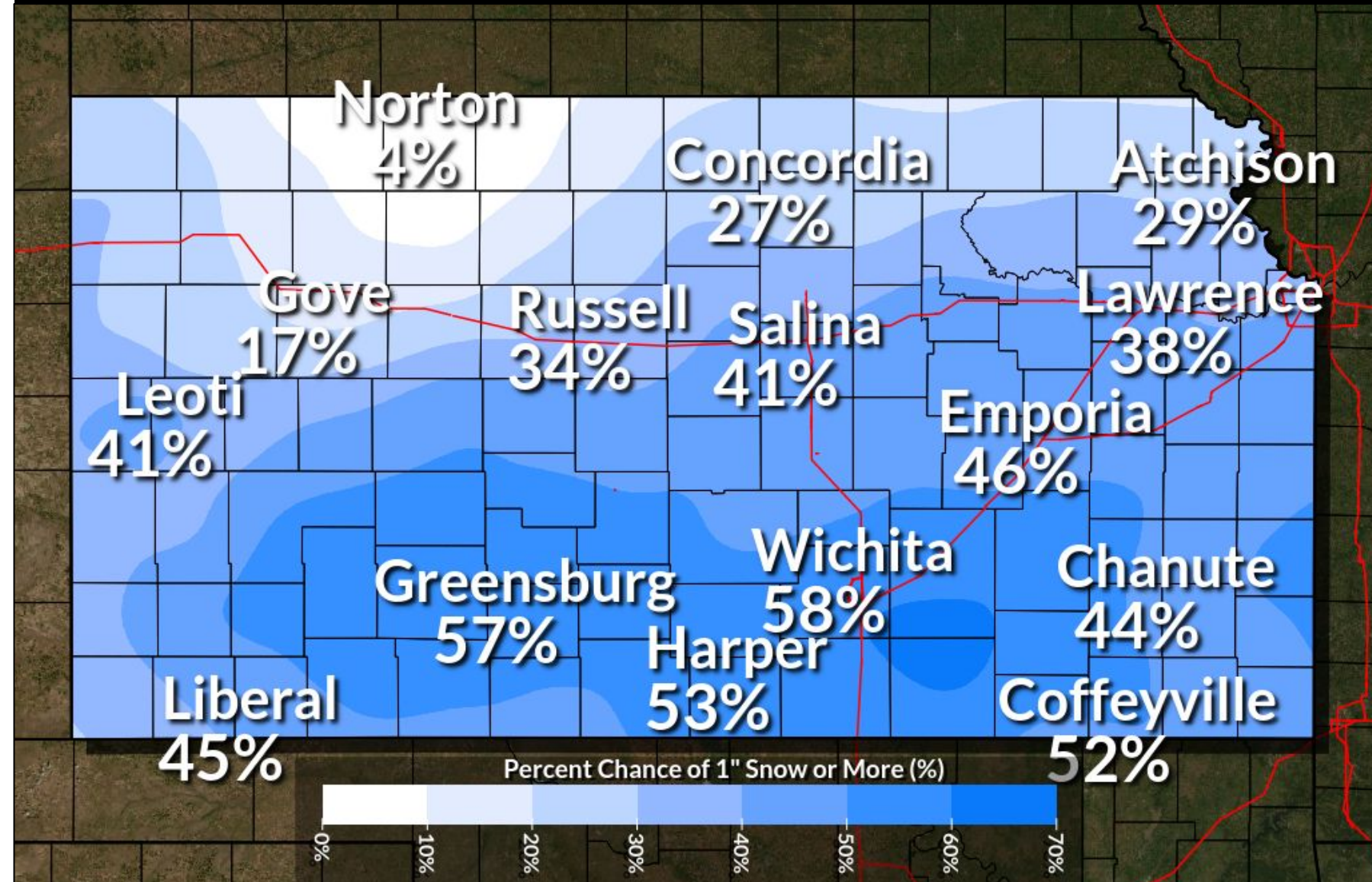
WHEN

- Late Saturday night through early Monday

IMPACTS

- Hazardous travel possible in snow, blowing snow, and poor visibilities.

Chance of at least **1 inch** of Snow

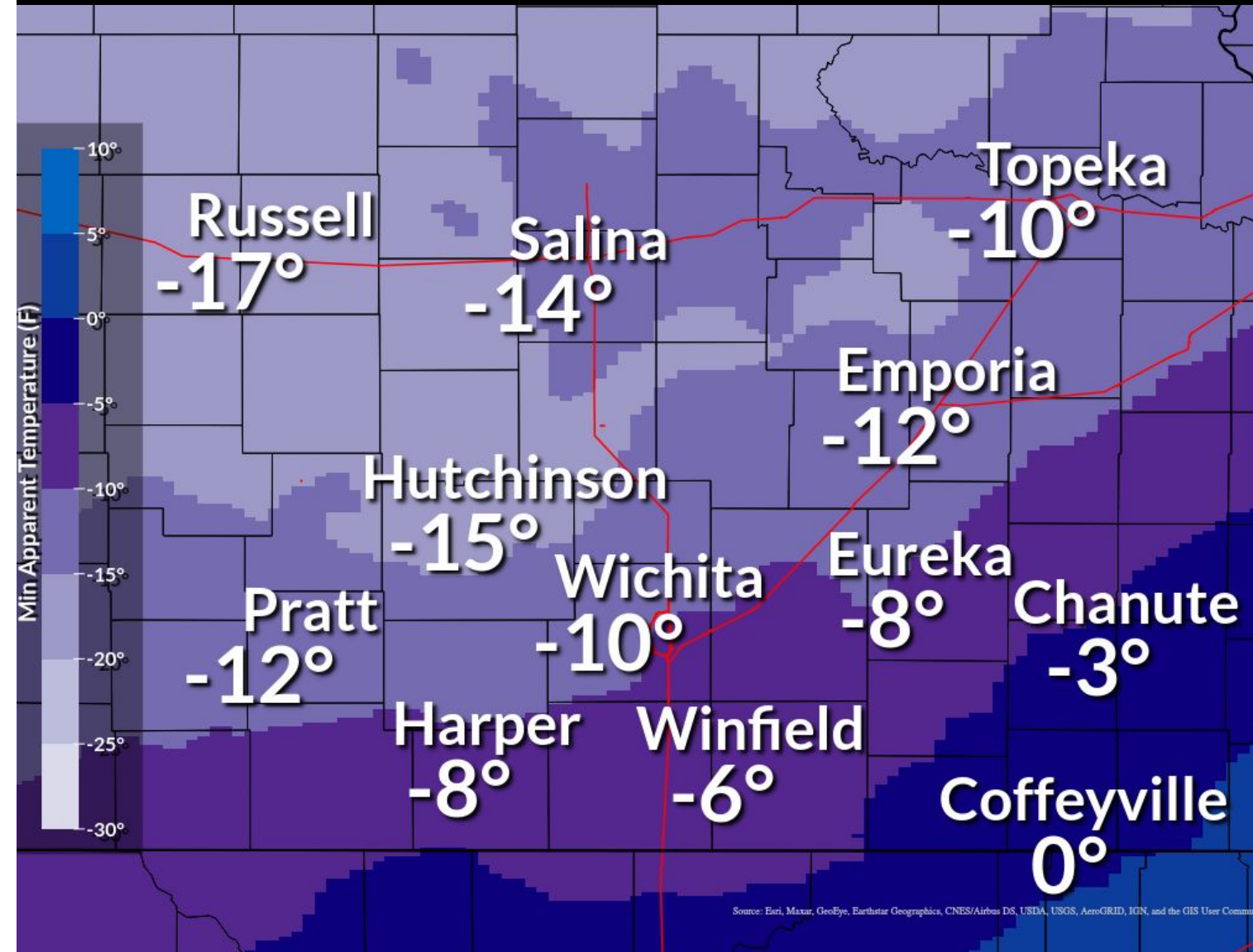




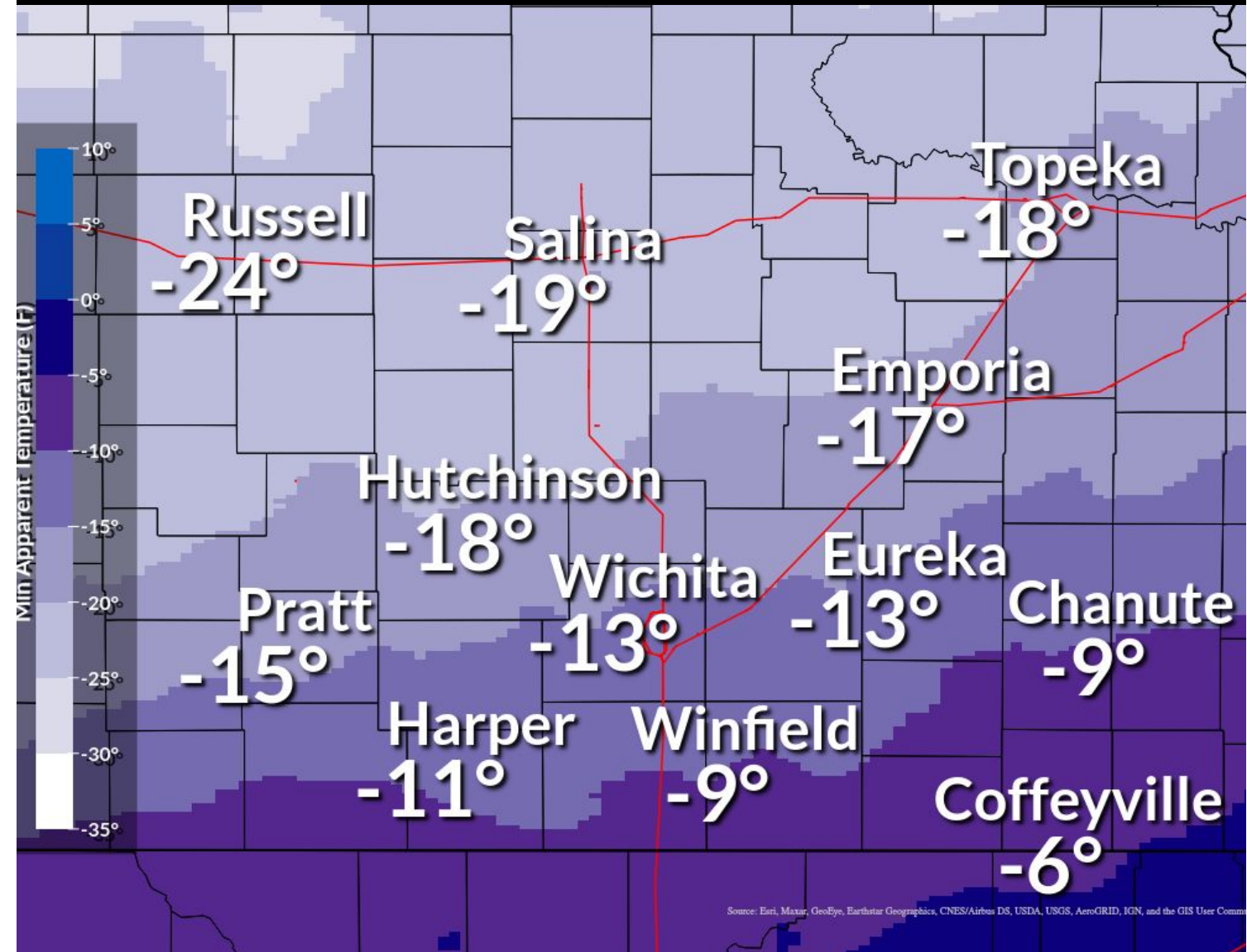

Saturday AM Wind Chills

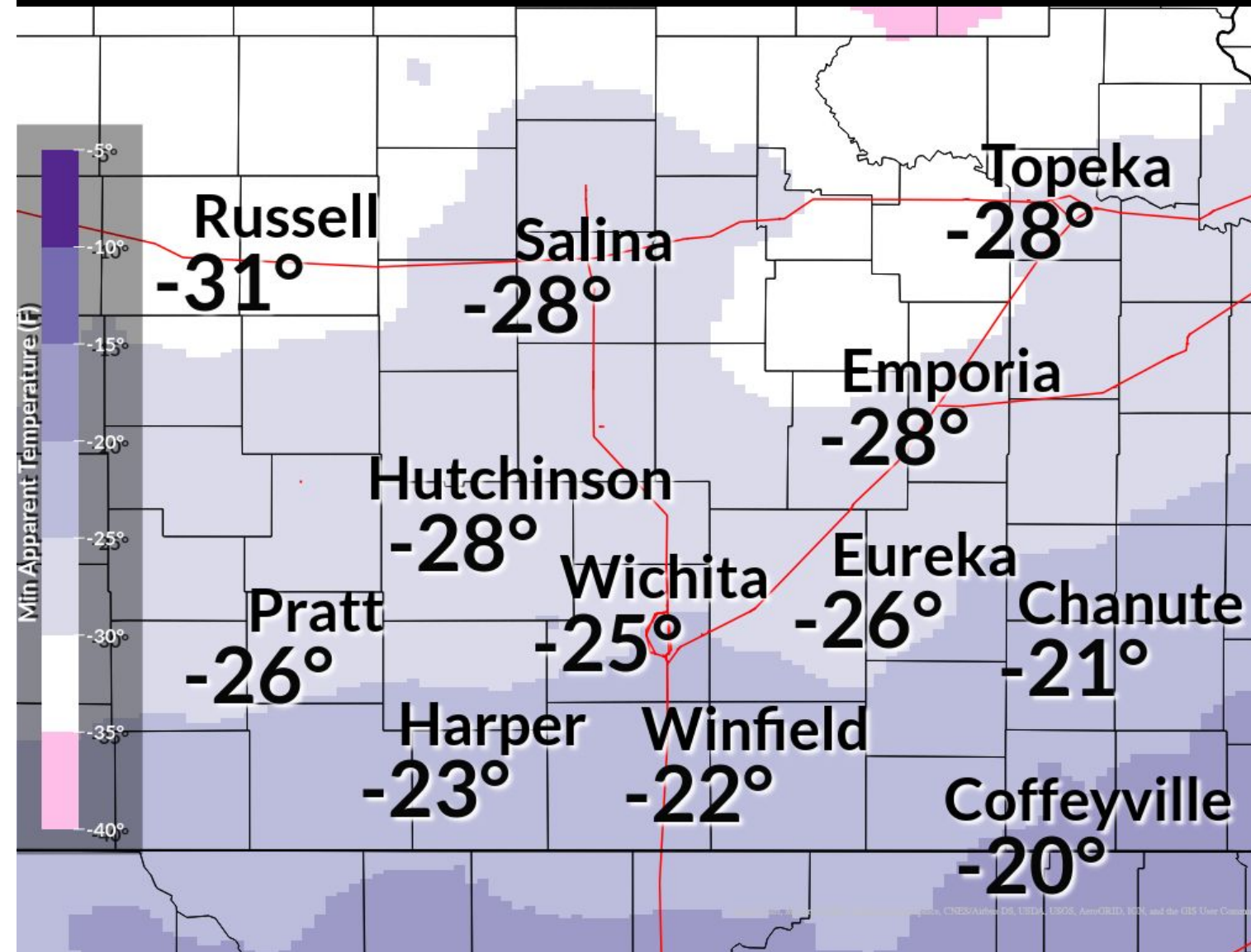




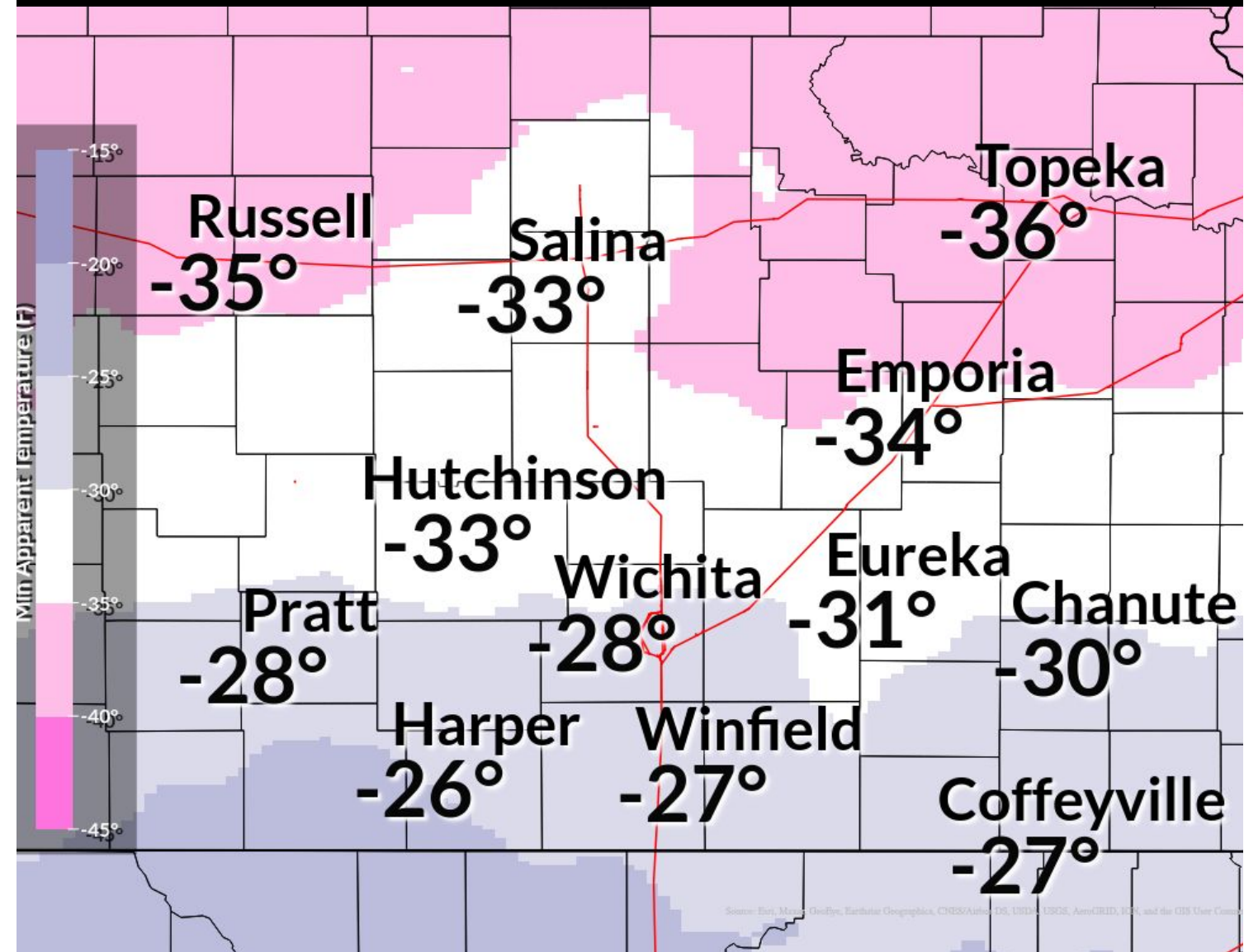

Monday AM Wind Chills

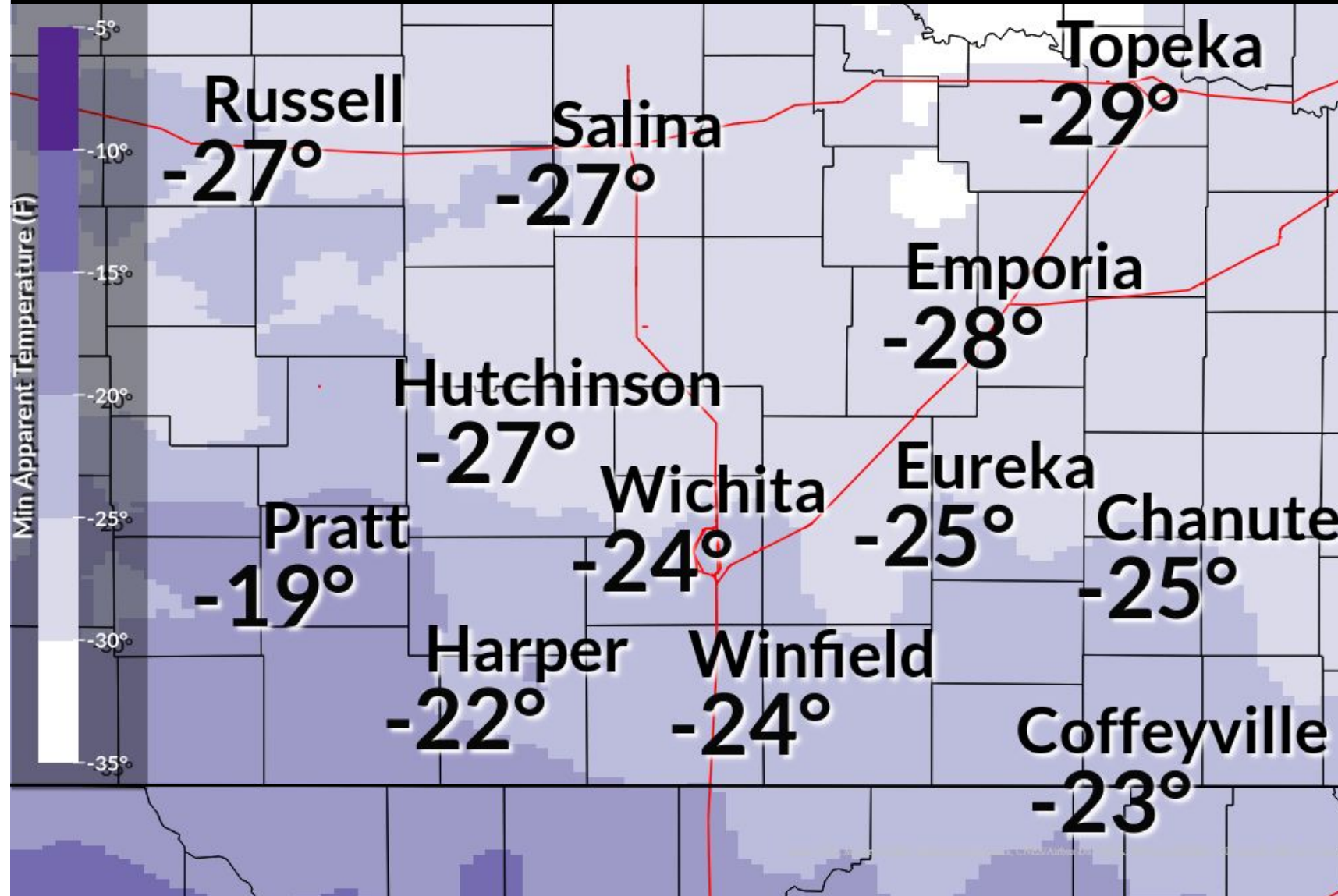
