

## Fire Danger and Very Windy Today

## Hazards & Impacts

EXTREME fire danger and VERY strong west-southwest winds. The strongest winds and highest fire danger will be over south-central and southeast Kansas. A gradual wind shift from southwest to west is expected during the afternoon and evening, making any fire suppression efforts increasingly difficult.

## Timing

Today 11 AM – 9 PM (High Wind Warning 1 PM - 7 PM)

### Confidence

• **HIGH confidence** for extreme fire danger and high winds.

## Critical fire weather conditions today!!

### WHAT

- → Critical fire weather conditions.
- → Afternoon RH's around 15% & wind gusts 50 to 60 mph


### When

→ 11 am to 9 pm today

### Impacts

- → Any fire that starts will be difficult to nearly impossible to control
- → Be mindful of anything that may cause a spark!

### WHAT

Southwest and west winds gusting to 55-60 mph

### When

Noon to 7 pm






### Impacts

- Any loose outdoor items need to be secured
- Tree damage and minor  $\rightarrow$ structure damage likely
- Driving will be difficult on  $\rightarrow$ north-south roads like I-135







→ Afternoon humidity will dip as low as 10% over southern Kansas

## WILDFIRE SAFETY
