Key Messages


- Multiple rounds of rain and thunderstorms with some severe storms and flooding possible












Increasing Flood Risk for this Weekend



Heavy Rainfall Amounts Possible



- Multiple rounds of showers and storms will bring heavy rainfall to the region over the next 3 days
- Flood Watch in effect for far Southeast Kansas where highest rainfall amounts are expected

What to do



Keep up with the latest forecasts

Prepare for the potential for flooded roads



Do not drive across water covered roadways





Forecast Confidence on Flood Risk Today - Monday

Location

Low Medium

Confidence is high that southeast Kansas will see the heaviest rainfall amounts and possible flooding

Timing

Confidence is increasing that the heaviest rainfall will occur between Saturday night and Sunday night

Magnitude

Low

Medium confidence that excessive rainfall will lead to flooding, there is potential for significant flooding to impact far southeast Kansas



3 SIMPLE STEPS FOR FLASH FLOOD SAFETY

During a flood, water levels and the rate at which the water is flowing can quickly change. Remain aware and monitor local radio and television.





- **ID GET TO HIGHER GROUND**Get out of the areas subject to Flooding
- DO NOT DRIVE INTO WATER
 Do NOT drive or walk into
 flooded areas. It only takes 6"
 of water to knock you off your
 feet.
- STAY INFORMED

 Monitor local radar, television,
 weather radio, internet or
 social media for updates.
