We ask that you be prepared to receive instructions according to the working methods that have been shown as a best practice, taking into account Habitat volunteers, staff supervisors, and government/organization regulations.

Please bring / wear the following:

- Closed-toe shoes
(no slippers or sandals allowed)
- Hat and/or bandana
- Sunblock and mosquito repellent
- Snack
- Refillable water bottle
- Packed lunch, *unless previous group lunch arrangements have been made*
