

Aloha Family Child Care Providers and Preschool Directors,

I wanted to share a couple of new feeding resources available to keiki across the island that you can share with your network.

1. CSA Produce Bag Pick-up - See attached flyer as well. We received a USDA grant and will be able to provide 1000 boxes a week x 6 weeks with an option to continue through summer. Distribution is from 11:30-pau at the following sites
  - Mondays - Kilauea Elementary
  - Tuesdays - Kapa'a High
  - Wednesdays - King Kaumuali'i Elementary
  - Thursdays - Koloa Elementary
  - Fridays - Kekaha Elementary
  
2. We also have received funding for CSA home deliveries to high-risk folks, mainly those who are low-income and cannot get to pantries or feeding sites (<http://www.malamakauai.org/mk/kauai-emergency-food-resources/>) due to transportation issues. Keiki, kupuna, disabled, domestic violence cases, etc. We have a full-time temporary driver who began delivering a few weeks ago and the program has been very successful. We are utilizing agency referrals as well as word of mouth and social media.
