  12. **Saddleseat WTC Championship, open to any rider who showed in a Saddleseat WTC Class. If gaited, non-gaited horses do favorite gait during slow gait and rack. TRICOLOR Neck Ribbon to Champion and Reserve Champion**

Entry Fees for regular classes are \$12 per class for outside or privately owned horses, and \$25 per class for CLS riders showing CLS school horses, or school horses half-leased from CLS.

Championship Classes are \$15 per class for outside or privately owned horses, and \$30 per class for CLS riders showing CLS school horses, or school horses half-leased from CLS.

## **Cash Lovell Stables Open Show Rules and Code of Conduct**

1. **The reason for this show is so that riders can BE SAFE, HAVE FUN and FALL IN LOVE WITH HORSE SHOWING!**
2. Everyone will be expected to work off their horse trailers. No stalls available, unless otherwise arranged with Parker.
3. **Negative Coggins tests will be required.**
4. Saddleseat classes are open to any of the show horse breeds, such as Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, Friesian and all half-breed show type horses. They also are open to any riders, regardless of whether the rider usually shows in traditional Academy classes or as "Show" or "Performance" riders. This is a FUN Show. Showing in FULL SUITS is NOT allowed. So showing in a CLS Saddleseat class does NOT disallow that rider to continue to show in sanctioned Academy classes.
5. **Rider's Attire: Barn or team shirts are encouraged, but not required. Appropriate riding pants and boots for the division are required. Helmets are required for all juvenile riders, ALL CLS riders regardless of age, and helmets are strongly encouraged for all other riders.**
6. Since this is not a USEF governed show, drug testers will not be on site. We ask, however, that exhibitors honor the spirit of our show and CLS's commitment to a drug free environment for our horses.
7. **This is an ALL BREED show.**
8. Martingales and basic training devices are allowed in all classes for all breeds.
9. **All show riders and trainers ride at their own risk.**
10. The judge's decisions are final. CLS will ask all unruly competitors to vacate the premises. CLS expects excellent horsemanship and sportsmanlike conduct at all times.
11. **CLS reserves the right to cancel or combine classes at show management's discretion.**
12. CLS prefers payment of Entry Fees in cash, please.
13. **The show arena will be opened for schooling starting at noon the day of the show.**
14. While held indoors, our shows are Weather Permitting because we do not have a large indoor warmup area for participants. Watch CLS's Social Media pages for weather updates the day of the show. Participants are welcome to warm up in CLS's barn aisle, or on the outside track. Please note that the center of our outdoor ring is being tilled for a barrel racing arena. But the outside track will be available for warmup.
15. **CLS promises that every participant will leave with a ribbon, and having heard his or her name called over the loudspeaker. We promise to do our best to make every participant feel special. We want horse showing to be FUN! If there is anything we can do better, please tell us!**
16. We are happy to add classes, as needed. We also will split classes.
17. **Our rule on split classes: If we have more than 8 riders per class, we will split classes, except for Championship Classes. This is at the judge's and management's discretion.**
18. Instructors who have riders in the same classes, please put an A,B,C beside each rider's name on the entry blank. A classes are for more advanced riders. B classes are for intermediate riders. C classes will be for beginner riders.
19. **Deadlines for entries: Friday, August 27. 6 pm. Changes to entries will be accepted until noon on Aug. 28.**

20. The CLS Tack Shop will offer 20 percent off all Clothing and other select items during each show!

**21. A full concession stand will be open during the show.**

22. Instructor's Prize: The Instructor who brings the most riders to a CLS Open Show will receive a \$50 CLS Tack Shop Gift Certificate!

**CLS riders see Ms. Parker for rules for showing CLS school horses. Five class maximum per horse. Riders may compete in unlimited classes, and show different horses in different divisions. Horses will be assigned on a first come basis, and riders must choose horses appropriate for their skill level, with Ms. Parker's decision being final.**



## **Sportsmanship Pledge**

**I pledge to ride my best when I enter the show ring. I pledge to work as a team with my horse, and I pledge to be kind to my horse always.**

**I pledge to prepare thoroughly, and to ride to the best of my abilities. I pledge to honor AND CARE FOR my horse, to respect my competitors, to respect the judge and his or her decisions, and to respect my instructors.**

**If I show any unsportsmanlike conduct, I know I will no longer be allowed to show horses under the CLS banner. I pledge to be a good sport to all, and a fine role model for all. If I have a question about my rides, I pledge to ask my instructor after the show, in private, about how I can learn the most from my rides.**

**I pledge to be thankful to my parents and family for allowing me to participate in a sport I love. Regardless of the ribbons, I know that I am a winner already because of my enormous accomplishments in getting here, and because of my instructor's pride in me.**

Showing horses isn't about winning. It's about riding.**
