2024 Goals:

Maintenance for Specific Roads:

1. Chip and fog seal 4.55 miles of CR-1 (Canyon Point to CR-24)
2. Apply pavement markings on same (above)
3. Install low-profile reflective centerline markers on 2.27 miles of CR-1 (Ponderosa to CR-24)
4. Install delineators on same (above)
5. Pavement repairs to 6.78 miles of roadway (CR-1, CR-22, CR-24, CR-24A & Mall Road)
6. Crack seal on same (above)
7. Gravel build-up 4.96 miles of CR-8 (Sleeping Indian to Owl Creek Gravel Pit)

Maintenance Activities:

3. Complete production of gravel at Owl Creek Gravel Pit (for CR-8 and CR-10)
