Apply to intended college

You will need:

- Official high school transcripts with test scores (ACT, SAT, ASVAB)
- Official college transcripts *if you have them*

Apply for Federal Financial Aid

at <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>

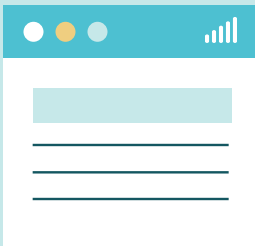
Information you will need to apply:

- Social Security Number
- Parents social Security Number (*only if you are a dependent student*)
- Driver's License Number
- Alien Registration number if you are not a US Citizen
- IRS W-2 Information, for yourself and your spouse (if married), and your parents (if you are a dependent)

Contact your school's Financial Aid office

Once you have been accepted to your intended school and you have received your FAFSA offer, you need to contact your school's Financial Aid Office.

Ask: What will be my out-of-pocket cost for ECE 101 & 103?

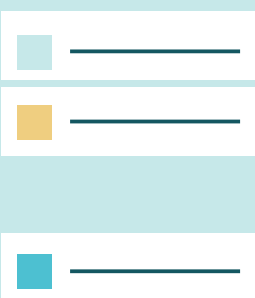
Register for ECE 101 & 103
