Increasing Access to COVID-19 Vaccines for Rural Health Clinics

All RHCs are eligible to receive direct shipments of their choice of COVID-19 vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, and/or Johnson & Johnson) through the [Rural Health Clinic COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution Program](https://www.hrsa.gov/coronavirus/rural-health-clinics/distribution) (<https://www.hrsa.gov/coronavirus/rural-health-clinics/distribution>). Changes for Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccines

As you may have heard there have been some important changes related to the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine that may be beneficial to your community:

- HRSA is now able to ship minimum orders of **450 doses** (down from 1,170 doses)
- Storage temperatures before puncture are between:
 - 2° C and 8° C (36° F and 46° F) for up to 1 month (31 days)
 - -80° C and -60° C (-112° F and -76° F) until the expiration date
- People **age 12 and older** are currently able to receive the Pfizer vaccine
