Prayers & Promises Month Seven

Week 27 7/1 - 7/7

God promises to walk with us in our troubles

“Though I am surrounded by troubles, you will protect me from the anger of my enemies. You reach out your hand, and the power of your right hand saves me.” Psalm 138:7 NLT

Week 28 7/8 – 7/14

God promises confident assurance (peace)

“Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.” John 14:27

NIV Notes: This is not “worldy peace” as in lack of conflict. This is the work of the Holy Spirit which is deep and lasting peace. It is peace in any conflict. It is confident assurance. With Christ’s peace, we have no need to fear the present or the future. The peace of God moves onto our hearts and lives in our hearts to restrain hostile forces and offers to comfort in peace of conflict.

Week 29 7/15 – 7/21

God promises an end to death, sorrow, and pain.

“He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.” Revelation 21:4

Week 30 7/29 – 8/4

God promises no fear of death

“Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.” Psalm 23:4 NIV

NIV Notes: Death casts a frightening shadow over us because we are completely helpless in its presence. Strength and courage cannot overcome death. Death has the final word. Only one can walk with us through death’s dark valley and bring us to the other side. God. He offers us eternal comfort.
