

D Dr. John Easter, our NetCon26 Keynote, will preach on Monday and Tuesday evenings of this year's annual conference. He serves as the Executive Director of Assemblies of God World Missions, where he provides strategic leadership for global missionary efforts and international ministry partnerships for the largest Pentecostal fellowship in the world. Decades of cross-cultural ministry experience gives him a world-view voice committed to advancing evangelism, church planting, and humanitarian outreach amidst our challenging global landscape. Don't miss hearing him!

We gather not just as individual leaders, but as one united body—called, equipped, and positioned for such a time as this. What we carry into the room has the power to ripple far beyond our state and into the nations. When we bring our resourcing together, we multiply impact; when we bring our hearts together, we multiply anointing. Information shared in unity becomes revelation; revelation stewarded in humility becomes transformation. Our synergy is not organizational—it is spiritual, strategic, and divinely orchestrated. As we align in prayer, we align with heaven's agenda for a global

movement. No ministry here is small—every assignment represented carries eternal weight. And we are not competing streams; we are converging rivers flowing into one global purpose.

Some of our sectional ministers may gather at various times Monday or Tuesday of NetCon. Check with your presbyter to see if you can connect with others from your area. When we gather in Erlanger you'll want to DEFINITELY register (no cost, free to attend, but registration is required) to attend the Sunday night Missions Celebration (off site). Then, Monday gets you started with breakfast provided by the U40! New Merch will be available--always a hit! Our Grow Conference returns with national speakers! And our first business session will be at 2pm. On Tuesday, you can land donuts from BGMC prior to our 2nd business session at 9am. At 2pm Tuesday, both Multicultural Ministries and our Women In Ministry groups have events! And don't miss this year's Ordination service Tuesday at 7pm. It's the largest group of Ordination candidates in KMN history, to our knowledge. We'll conclude Tuesday night, but that doesn't skip those ladies interested in connecting with our Women's Ministries for a breakfast (off site) on Wednesday morning!

When our hearts unite in cooperative fellowship, our individual anointings, our distinctive strengths weave together into a force far greater than any could create alone. In shared purpose and mutual trust, we don't just overcome ministry obstacles we all deal with in our towns, cities, and churches—we transform them into stepping stones toward God's extraordinary.

The **GROW CONFERENCE** happens on Monday, April 27, from 9AM to 12Noon. Our guest speakers are Gerad Strong, Church Multiplication Network Director, and Dwight Sandoz, Co-Director of Rural Advancement.

GROW CONFERENCE SCHEDULE
9-11AM Session One: The Local Church Revitalized and Growing In Every Community Across Kentucky

Discussion Points: Kentucky is mostly rural, but with large suburban and inner-city communities. How do we grow our existing churches in each geographic setting, revitalize the thinking of existing congregations to move beyond plateau or declining numbers, develop stronger ministry teams within our local church, and consider both traditional and unconventional church planting options in Kentucky for the next decade.

11AM-12PM Session Two: Growth Strategies for Rural Pastors in Small and Medium-Size Churches

Discussion Points: Nearly 85 of Kentucky's 120 counties are classified as rural, with 54 being entirely rural, representing over 41% (1.9 million people) of our state's population of 4.6 million. The majority of our KYAG churches are in rural settings with amazing opportunities to grow and impact their communities. This session will encourage our rural pastors and ministers and offer practical and proven ways to grow these congregations.



I've spoken several times with Gerad and Dwight over the last few months and know they and their teams are working hard to offer quality material and resources to assist in these topics of discussion. I encourage you to attend, and if possible, bring with you some key staff, board, and church leaders to share in the experience.




