Diagnostic Advances in Surgical Pathology and Cytopathology

This two-day interactive course will address key updates in genitourinary, gynecologic, gastrointestinal and liver, lung and head/neck pathology. A stepwise approach to pathology diagnosis in these subspecialty topic areas in surgical pathology and cytopathology will be addressed. The course will also provide guidance in the use and interpretation of molecular and immunohistochemical testing in difficult diagnostic scenarios.

Specific topics that will be covered include: prostate cancer classification and grading, invasive bladder cancer subtypes and variants, challenges in urine cytology, inflammation and infection of the gastrointestinal tract, pattern-based approaches to liver biopsies, gastrointestinal polyps, lung cancer classification and molecular testing, salivary gland neoplasms, milian classification system, frozen section interpretation of pelvic lesions, pseudoneoplasms and mimics of endometrial carcinoma, atypical glandular cells on pap smear, head and neck neoplasms, and sinonasal lesions.

The format includes interactive didactic and video microscopy sessions presented by internationally recognized guest speakers and expert subspecialty faculty from the University of California, San Diego.

Target Audience: This course is designed for practicing pathologists across community and academic centers and pathology residents and fellows.
