CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Dear Pediatric Trainee:

The Pennsylvania Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics' (PA AAP) annual Pediatric CME Conference, ***Addressing Challenges in Modern Pediatrics***, will be held in-person from Saturday, March 11 through Sunday, March 12 at the Renaissance Hotel in Allentown, PA.

The PA AAP would like to invite you to submit an abstract for our Trainee Poster Session. Abstract submissions are due no later than **Wednesday, February 20, 2023, by 5:00 pm**. Applicants will be informed of their acceptances by February 27, 2023.

Trainee Poster Session:

Posters will be showcased during our participant reception, beginning at 5:00 pm on the first day of the Conference, March 11. Posters must be set up in the designated exhibition space at the Renaissance Hotel before 9:00 am ET on March 11; they will only be displayed on Saturday, March 11, but all presenters are welcome to attend the entire two-day event. **Trainees who are presenting posters must be in attendance while posters are showcased.**

Presenters must be a pediatric trainee (medical student, resident or fellow) and a member of the PA AAP. Registration for the Pediatric CME Conference is \$30 for all trainee members. Visit our [website](#) to view the conference agenda and register.

To submit your abstract for consideration in PA AAP's Poster Session, please email adangelo@paaap.org, utilizing the following guidelines for poster session abstracts.

Abstracts will be reviewed and accepted based on content as well as adherence to the stated guidelines. The abstract should be no more than 1,000 words.

1. **Title:** Type abstract title in upper case letters and bold.
2. **Authors and affiliations:** List authors and affiliations. Presenter's name should be underlined and listed first.
3. **Background:** Describe why the study or program was undertaken.
4. **Objective:** Clearly state the objectives of the study or program.
5. **Design/Methods:** Describe the methods of data collection and analysis, or the activities developed to address the program objectives.
6. **Results:** What do the data show? What did the program accomplish? If the study or program is still ongoing, present the data currently available.
7. **Conclusion:** State in one or two sentences what the study demonstrated or the program accomplished. The conclusion should be supported by data rather than the author's opinion. If the study is still in progress and results are not available, state what has been accomplished to date.

Deadline for submission of abstract per the instructions above is Wednesday, February 15, 2023. Notification of acceptance/poster specification guidelines will be emailed by February 27, 2023. Please contact Aubrey D'Angelo(adangelo@paaap.org) with any questions.
