

# October 5, 2019

Thank you for your interest in Art on the Avenue, a multicultural arts and music festival organized by the Del Ray Community Partnership, and hosted by the Del Ray neighborhood of Alexandria. The show welcomes applications from all craft artists, and is known for high quality artwork in a friendly, neighborhood atmosphere.

#### Please read this letter carefully, even if you have participated in the show before.

This is a juried show and all work must be original, handmade, created and exhibited by the approved artist. Our show attracts customers because they know they'll have personal contact with artists so please do not send a representative to sell your work.

Applications mailed by April 1st have the best chance of being accepted into the show. However, we continue to accept applications after April 1st until all spaces have been filled. The fee for 2019 is \$200 for applications postmarked before April 1st, \$225 after April 1st. Acceptance is NOT guaranteed for returning artists.

The number of artists in each category will be limited to ensure a balanced distribution of art forms. Once a category, such as jewelry, painting, photography, etc., reaches the limit, that category will be closed, and remaining artist applications put on a waiting list. Any application that includes jewelry will be judged in the jewelry category and be subject to the limits on numbers of jewelry artists.

The application should include a completed application form, a check for the application fee made out to Art on the Avenue, a **minimum of 3 photos and a maximum of 6 photos** (good quality home printed images acceptable). Digital files, and transparencies are NOT acceptable. Please note prices on the back of each image. **Images should accurately represent the work that will be displayed.** You may submit and show work in more than one category, but you must include at least one photo of each category of work. Mail applications to Art on the Avenue, P.O. Box 2826, Alexandria VA 22301. **Please use a 6.5 x 9.5 or smaller envelope and maximum of 6 photos. No staples or paper clips. No padded envelopes.** 

We usually try to place returning artists at or close to their previous location, unless an artist asks to be moved. We will try to accommodate requests but cannot guarantee assignment of the requested space.

There are a limited number of corner spaces available for an additional fee of \$120. If you want a corner, enclose a SEPARATE CHECK for \$120. We never have enough corners for all who want them, so if we can't assign you to a corner we'll shred that additional check. Corners will be assigned to reflect a variety of art forms and to allow a variety of artists to showcase their work in these prominent locations. Also, please be aware that all spaces next to openings are considered "corners". Some are on actual street corners and some are at the edges of other openings from the street that also have high visibility.

Each space is **10 feet by 10 feet**. Tents, displays, art, supplies, chairs and other items must be kept within the assigned space and may not encroach into the adjacent space or street, into any sidewalk or onto private property. Artists who use tents must have weights in case of windy weather. There is no electricity or water available to artists.

Cancellations must be made in writing or by email and must be received before August 31st, in order to receive a 50% refund. No refunds after August 31st. If you are not accepted into the show we will notify you by email and shred your check. Photos of artwork will NOT be returned.

#### **Application Timeline**

April 1 - Applications at standard booth rate of \$200 must be postmarked by April 1st

**After April 1st** - Application fee rises to \$225

**End of June** - Information packages mailed to artists who applied by June 1st and have been juried into the show. Notification sent to artists who have not been accepted.

June through end of September - Any remaining spaces are filled by the judges as applications are received

August 31st - Cancellations must be made in writing, by mail or email by August 31st to receive a 50% refund.

### **Logistics for Artists During Art on the Avenue**

7:00 AM	Mount Vernon Avenue closes to traffic. Artists are allowed on the Avenue to unload. Vehicles must be moved off the Avenue as soon as items have been dropped off. Artists may set up after their vehicle has been parked off the Avenue. <b>No tents on Mt Vernon Avenue before 7:00am is a safety requirement.</b> Set up must be completed by 9:45am.
10:00 AM = 6:00 PM	Art on the Avenue is open to the public rain or shipe

10:00 AM – 6:00 PM Art on the Avenue is open to the public, rain or shine

6:00 PM – 7:00 PM Breakdown starts at 6:00pm. Folded tents and packed artwork must be on the sidewalk before

artists get their cars. Breakdown should be completed by 7:00pm, when the Avenue will re-open to traffic. Once artwork, tent and any other equipment are packed up on the sidewalk, artists will be given a colored ticket by the block captain allowing them to bring their vehicle onto Mt.

Vernon Avenue for loading..

7:00 PM Mount Vernon Avenue opens to traffic.

Please note that there is no dedicated parking for artists. Limited parking is available on neighborhood streets surrounding the show. There is also a large parking lot in front of the Target store located at 3101 Jefferson Davis Highway in the Potomac Yard Shopping Center, about a 10 minute walk from the north end of the show, and a parking lot behind the George Washington Middle School located at 1005 Mt Vernon Avenue, about a 10 minute walk from the south end of the show.
