The log plank construction was typical of the time, but few examples have survived. Come hear our own tragic Romeo and Juliet story related to this house and also witness the unsolved mystery of who carved the sailing ships into the exterior logs. A visit to the Hill House is a step back in time into a typical home of the early residents of Chincoteague Island. It's not just a look at history but a chance for you to stand inside history!</p>
