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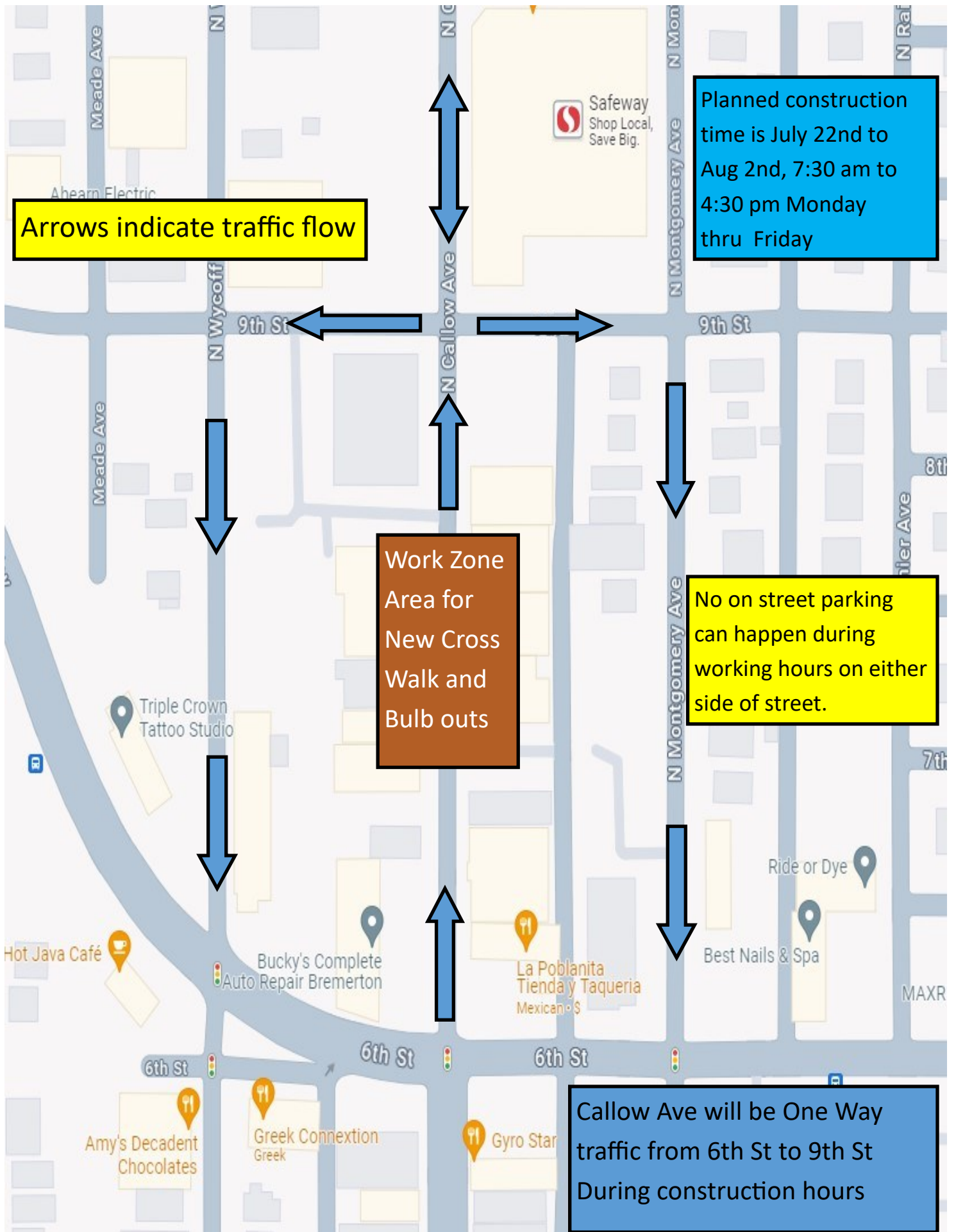

Road Construction Report

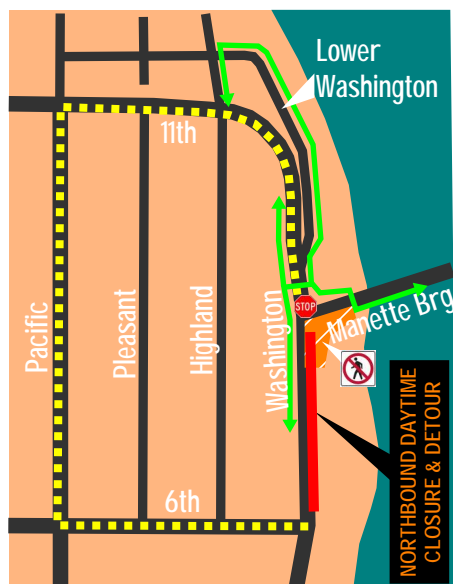

ROUNABOUT CONSTRUCTION (PHASE 2)

Beginning Monday, July 8 work will begin on the southeast corner of Washington Ave and the Manette Bridge. The expected duration of this work is approximately 3-4 weeks subject to change based on weather and unforeseen conditions.

Intermittent Flagging at Intersection Required



DETOURS AND CLOSURES: This work will require a detour of northbound Washington Ave traffic during weekday non-peak hours (8:30 am to 2:30 pm) as depicted. Washington Ave between 6th St and the Manette Bridge will remain open to local traffic during this detour to provide access to adjacent properties and a flagger will assist local traffic through the Washington Ave and Manette Bridge intersection. Local traffic should expect minor delays during these periods at the intersection.

TRAFFIC CHANGES: The intersection of Washington Ave and the Manette Bridge will remain as an all-way stop. Narrowing of traffic lanes will be required. Over-sized vehicles should use alternate routing via Warren Ave (SR 303). Lane shifts on Washington Ave and 11th St in the work area may occur.

PEDESTRIANS: Temporary crosswalks will be provided near Washington Ave and the Manette Bridge to provide pedestrian access around the work area. Pedestrian detour routes will be signed. The sidewalk along the Manette Bridge will remain open.

CYCLIST: Portions of existing bike lanes near the work area may be temporarily impacted. Cyclist may follow local access route or seek alternate route.

PARKING: Impacts to existing on-street parking are not anticipated. Any necessary temporary parking restrictions will be signed.
