



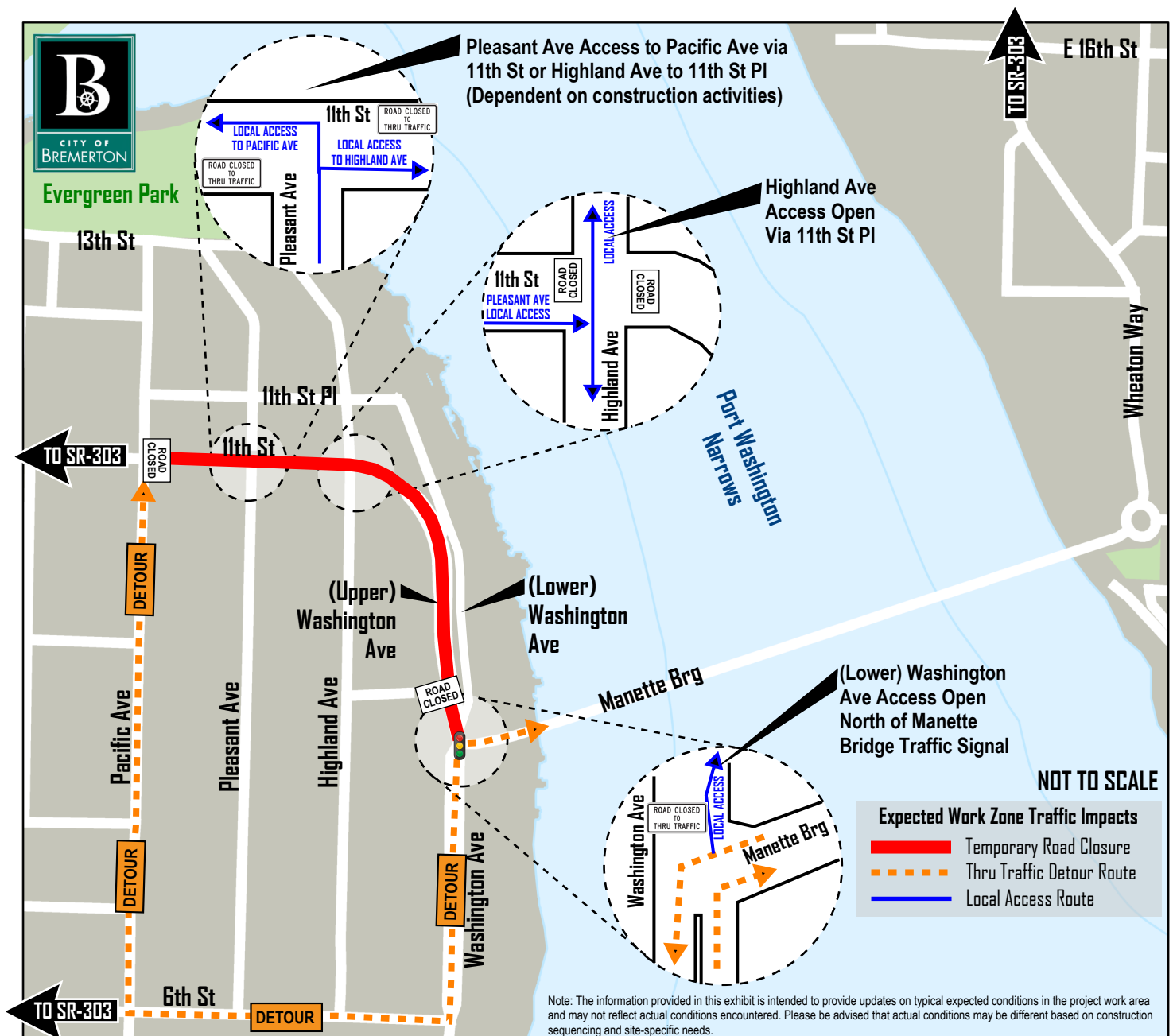

WASHINGTON AVENUE & 11TH STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

Beginning on or around **February 12, 2024** a temporary closure of 11th St and Washington Ave (between Pacific Ave and the Manette Bridge) will occur for approximately 3 months to allow for a full reconstruction of the roadway.

THRU TRAFFIC: A detour will be provided along Pacific Ave and 6th St. Access to and from the Manette Bridge will remain open, however no thru traffic will be permitted on Washington Ave north of the Manette Bridge.

LOWER WASHINGTON RESIDENTS: A local access driveway will be maintained immediately north of the Washington Ave / Manette Bridge signal for local traffic.

HIGHLAND & PLEASANT RESIDENTS: The intersections of 11th St at Highland Ave and Pacific Ave will remain open for local traffic. Local access to and from Pacific Ave along 11th St will be provided when possible, however some work may require a detour along 11th St Place.

PEDESTRIANS: Sidewalk within the road closure is subject to closure and detour routes will be signed. Sidewalk along Lower Washington and 11th St Place will remain open for access between Pacific Ave and the Manette Bridge.

ON-STREET PARKING: To be restricted along limits of closure on 11th St and Washington Ave. On-street parking restrictions may occur outside the work area along detour routes to provide sufficient space for larger vehicles.
